QUORN SKATE PARK FUNDING ONE STEP CLOSER

The Quorn Skate Park facility is one step closer to being built with the announcement of \$64,000 funding support from the State Local Government Infrastructure Partnership.

Peter Slattery, Mayor of The Flinders Ranges Council said "The Quorn Skate Park construction has been on the Council and community agenda for some years now and it's great that some funding support has been offered from this program."

"The funding is supported by \$25,000 worth of fundraising from the community as well as a contribution from the Council. We are in the process of applying for funding from another grant to hopefully secure the final dollars to ensure the project happens".

Dr Jen Cleary, Chairperson of RDA Far North said "A facility such as this Skate Park is important for the township of Quorn in terms of not just providing a great facility for the local youth, but also for roll on effects and benefits for tourism and other local businesses which all assist to boost the local and regional economies".

In total more than \$23 million is being offered to 26 Councils across the State, including more than \$12 million to 15 regional Councils.
